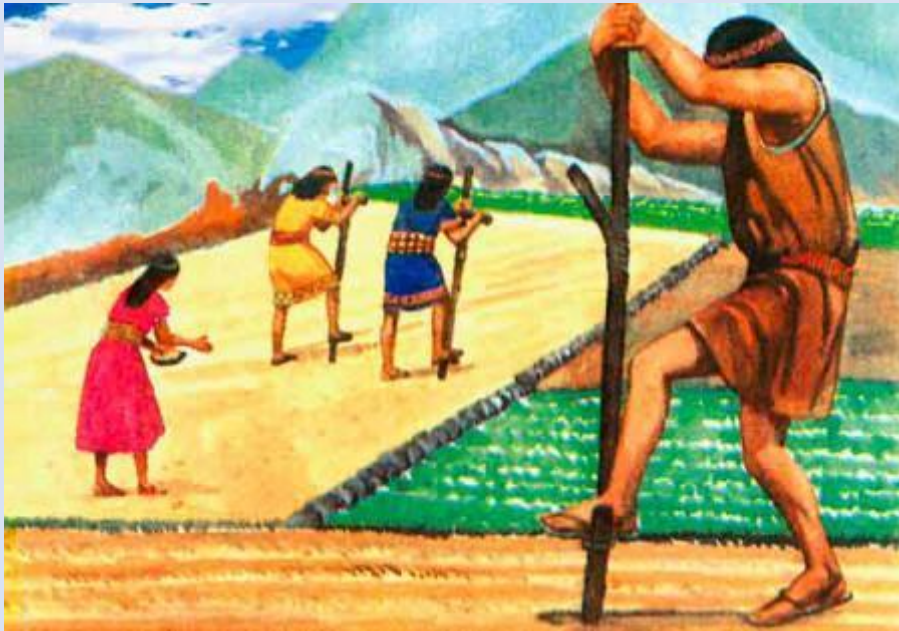


THE AYLLU (Inkas)

The Inca Nobles had a better life, they used to live better. They worked but didn't have to pay taxes to the government. Only rich people could travel.

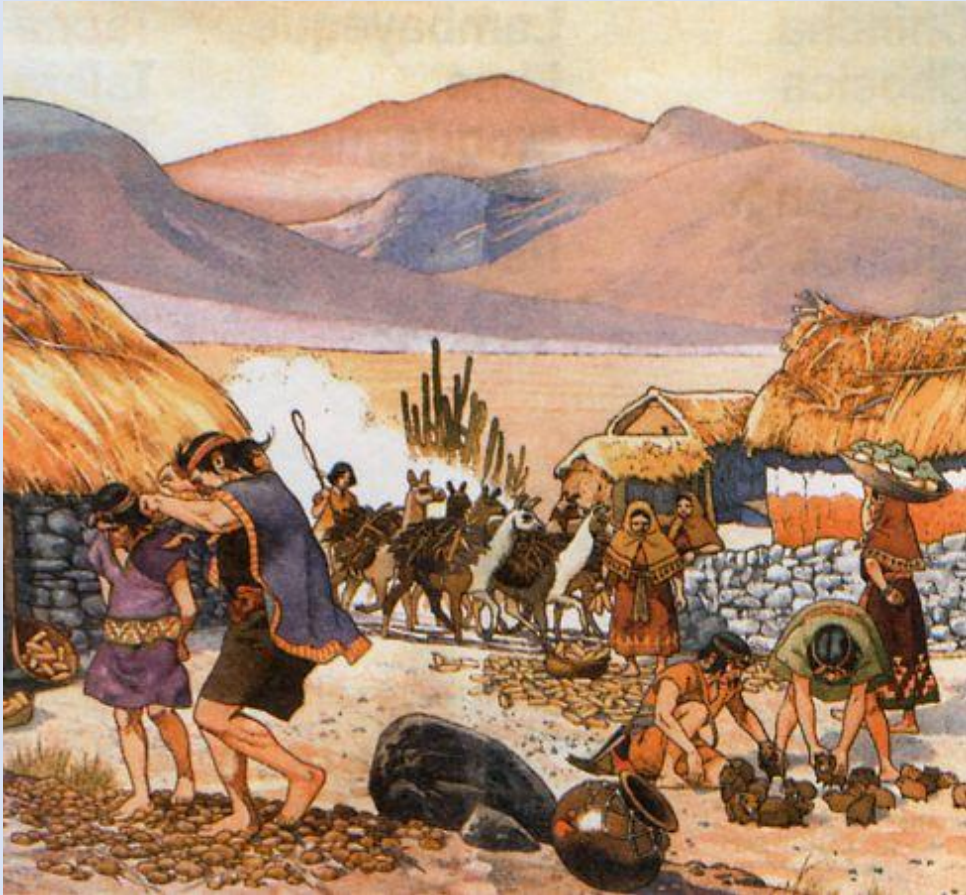


Their food
